3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. For Stud Dog and two, but not more than 4, of their Get. Owner of Stud dog need not be necessarily the owner of the Get. Stud dog only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Competition of the Get in regular or non-regular class (other than Stud Dog) is required. Fee \$5.00 as a unit if Stud Dog and Get are entered in regular class. If Stud Dog is not entered in a class of the show then a fee of \$15.00 is required.

BROOD BITCH CLASS

For Brood Bitch and two, but not more than 4, of their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not be necessarily the owner of the Produce. Brood Bitch only to be judged based on the merits of the Produce. Competition of the Produce in regular or non-regular class (other than Brood Bitch) is required.
