Special thanks go out to FHSS Members **Kim Sinclair** and **Marcia Harding** for assembling the displays so quickly.

"*I think it's phenomenal,*" said Pritchett, flanked by **George Canyon's** tailored white shirt, jeans, boots and hat, a dark-blue sequined outfit donated by **Anne Murray**, and a two-tone purple spangled suit worn by the Centre's namesake – **Hank Snow**. Pritchett said the showcase impressed him. "*It's a great way to show all Canadians who come to the area all the talent that has come out of this country.*" Pritchett said he was only too happy to support the venture. 

HSCMC Preparing to Increase Public Access to its Archives

Thanks to many generous donations and bequests, the FHSS currently has over 9000 items catalogued in our archives. The HSCMC receives many requests for information contained in the archives, which includes many different types of material, from audio recordings to songbooks, performance videos, and taped interviews, as well as fan club newsletters, articles,

and photographs. The staff often answers these questions by referring to material on the archive rooms' crowded shelves. Now, the archives has reached a point where it needs focused attention in order to grow and be accessible as a source of information about Hank for museum visitors, fans, and researchers of all sorts.

Last winter, **Wendy Rofihe**, a big fan of Hank's music and gorgeous suits, was visiting the museum as she had many times before. After expressing interest in seeing the two suits that had just been obtained, she began talking with **Lauren** and learned about the archives. Wendy has been away from her native Nova Scotia for some time, recently finishing an MA degree in Canadian Studies specializing in heritage conservation, in addition to a BA in art history and years of experience in the garment and film industries in Toronto, Montreal, and Ottawa. While living away brought many amazing opportunities and experiences, at the time Wendy was in the process of deciding it was time to get back to her "Nova Scotia Home" in nearby LaHave, Lunenburg County. Without even knowing the full extent of the museum's archival holdings, she proposed to Lauren and the FHSS board that she was the ideal person to oversee the archives into the future. With the dual goals of making them financially self-sustaining, and to enhance their use as a part of Hank's legacy which the museum shares with his many fans, the board enthusiastically agreed. Wendy began working on the archives on a volunteer basis at the end of April.

To have comprehensive and accessible archives has always been a part of the FHSS's vision for the HSCMC. But, as the fine example set by the library and archives at the Country Music Hall of Fame in Nashville shows, it also requires a lot of resources—in 2003 it accounted for 1/3 of their entire budget. Among other things, Wendy is busy investigating private and public funding options, and preparing projects to submit to various programs meant to assist archives in making material available to the public. We hope, before long, anyone interested will be able to search the database and request material off the shelves to view in person at the museum. After that, the archives should flourish thanks to the continued generosity of present and future donors, and the ever-increasing interest in Hank's incredible career!




Photo of our Black Marble Plaque with some of the many names of donors who have already contributed.
