

Praem., who will speak on the more recent, profound events that brought him through the cross of cancer to a miraculous recovery. Father Abbot will share how the intercessory power of the praying community at St. Michael's Norbertine Abbey drew God's mercy upon him in his hour of vulnerability. His story will inspire you to persevere with courage and faith in Jesus Christ under the most difficult of circumstances.

Father Abbot Eugene's love of the Church, and his joy in service of the Lord, is contagious. Not only has Father Abbot personally received the healing touch of Jesus Christ, but the Lord has used him to heal His people. One of these miraculous healings is recorded in a book on Eucharistic healing that refers to the occasion of the *Magnificat* Divine Mercy Conference at UCI when Father Abbot carried the Blessed Sacrament in procession, and stopped to pray over a lady in a wheel chair who received a healing!

In 1990 Fr. Eugene received the degree of Doctor of Canon Law from the Catholic University in Washington DC. In July 1988 the General Chapter of the Norbertine Order elected Fr. Eugene as it procurator general. In this capacity he lived in Rome and represented the Order to various departments of the Vatican and he served as a part-time professor at the Angelicum and also the Pontifical Institute, Regina Mundi, for religious sisters. In June 1995 Fr. Eugene was elected by his confreres as the second Abbot of St. Michael's Abbey and received his abbatial blessing from Bishop McFarland on September 15, 1995.

Due to its vocational prosperity (over 70 members with median age of 42), the Abbey attracted publicity in an article from the Catholic World Report and was featured recently on EWTN.

Abbot Eugene Hayes truly exemplifies the love of the heart of the Eternal High Priest. His paternal charity and humility draws people to Jesus Christ. Invite a friend to be blessed by this gifted priest and Father.
